The History of Gloucester Nursery School

Gloucester Nursery School was officially opened on Friday, December 1st 1950 as a purpose-built nursery school. It offered excellent nursery education and care on a part-time and full-time basis to children aged 3 and 4 years, before they were admitted to primary school.

In 1992 the nursery was extended and the building began to be used by local families and the community. Between 2010 and July 2014 a Surestart Children's Centre was based within the nursery building.

In September 2015 Gloucester Nursery School opened its doors to 2 year old children in a new separate, purpose built building in the grounds of the existing Nursery. This provided a stimulating environment in which the children could flourish.
