We are like monkeys jumping on the bed and


Getting on and off...






Getting up was tricky until Yaseen had a great idea.

Reece thought that 10,000 could fit into this hole.


The rings in a tree can tell you how old it is. Andrew and Charlie tried to count them, "1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10."

Bubbles!


Sticks from the Elder tree are perfect for blowing bubbles. Dip the tube gently into the mixture and then blow through the end. It's quite tricky though!


Junior, Zhe and Kym really enjoyed saying, "Dip, dip, dipety, dip!"

Oh no! Where is




What can it be?
