# Potions...



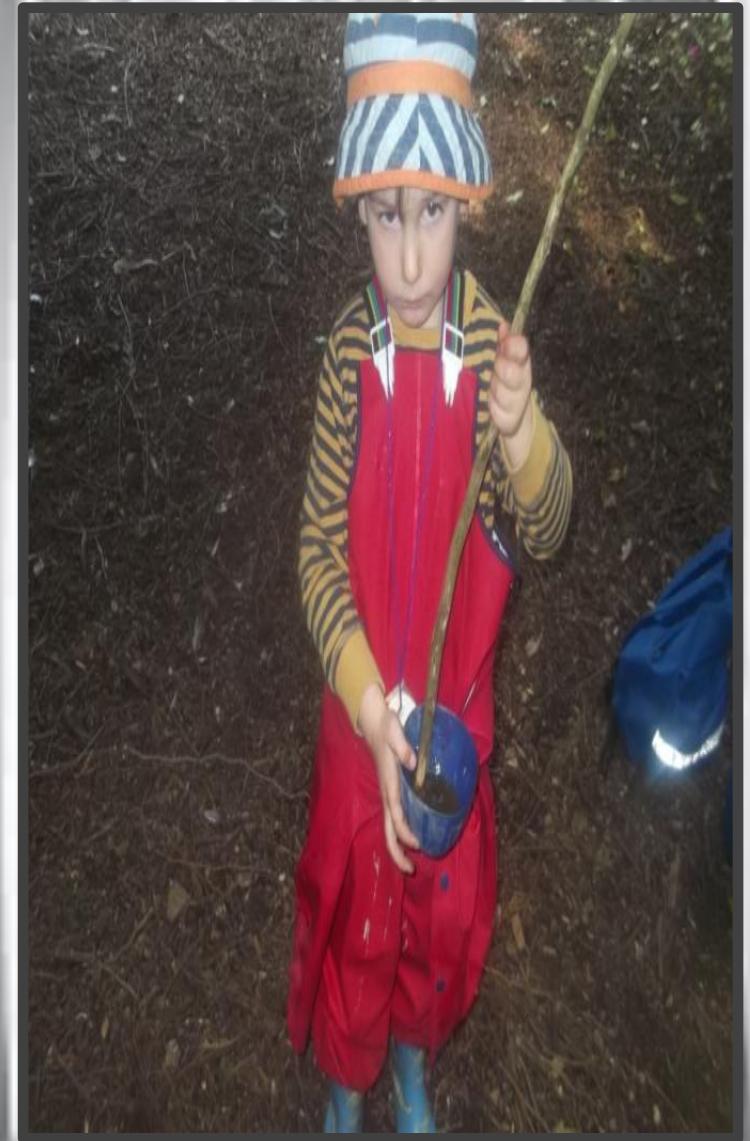
We found all the things that we needed on the forest floor today. If you add a few squirts of a magical liquid and mix well, you can make a wish.
